#### Today's Gospel Reading (John 3: 13-21) Our Lord Jesus Christ says:

No one has ascended into heaven but he who descended from heaven, the Son of man. And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, so must the Son of man be lifted up, that whoever believes in Him may have eternal life." For God so loved the world that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life. For God sent the Son into the world, not to condemn the world, but that the world might be saved through Him. He who believes in Him is not condemned; he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God. And this is the judgment, that the light has come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil. Խաչվերացի տօնախմբութիւնը կը տեւէ լման շաբաթ մը։ Միւս բոլոր քրիստոնեայ Եկեղեցիները կը տօնեն զայն Սեպտեմբեր 14-ին, նոգ չէ թէ շաբթուան որ օրուան ճանդիպի։ Իսկ Հայաստանեայց Եկեղեցին, ըստ իր որդեգրած սկզբունքին, որով անխախտ թուականի կապուած կարգ մը մեծ տօներ կը փոխադրէ մերձաւորագոյն Կիրակիին, Խաչվերացը կը կատարէ Սեպտեմբեր 14-ի մօտաւորագոյն Կիրակիին, այսինքն, 11-17-ի միջեւ։

Քրիստոնէական եկեղեցիին կողմէ թէ՛ Աստուածամօր եւ թէ՛ Խաչին հանդէպ

սնուցուած բացառիկ յարգանքը եւ սէրը ունեցած է մէկ եւ նոյն դրդապատճառը։ Երկուքն ալ Քրիստոսի կեանքին եւ Անոր հիմնական երկու տնօրինութեանց հետ սերտօրէն կապուած են իրենց կարեւորութիւնը կը ստանայ Քրիստոսի հետ ունեցած այս կապէն։ Աստուածամայրը անաբաժանելիօրէն կապուած է *Մարդեղութեան* մեծ խորհուրդին հետ։ Իսկ Խաչը՝ *Փրկագործութեան* հետ։ Խաչը այլեւս դարձած է համայն Քրիստոնէութեան խորհրդանշանը։

Վերացումն Խաչի։ 614 թուականին Պարսիկներ կը գրաւեն Երուսաղէմը, կը քանդեն ու կ'աւարեն զայն։ Այդ կապուտ–կողոպուտի մէջ կը գտնուի նաեւ Քրիստոսի հարազատ խաչը, զոր Պարսիկներ գերի կը տանին իրենց երկիրը։ Կը սթափին ի վերջոյ քրիստոնեաներ եւ հսկայ բանակ մը կազմած Բիւզանդիոնի Հերակլ կայսեր գլխաւորութեան ներքեւ, 628 թուականին Պարսիկները պարտութեան կը մատնեն եւ կ'ազատեն Սբ. Խաչը։ Քրիստոնէական այս բանակին մէջ կայ նաեւ հայագունդ մը Մժէժ Գնունի հայ նախարարի հրամանատարութեան ներքեւ, որ կարեւոր դեր կը կատարէ յաղթանակին մէջ։

Խաչը բերուեցաւ Կոստանդնուպոլիս, ուր ատեն մը մնալէ յետոյ կայսրը անձամբ տարաւ զայն ու զետեղեց իր պատմական վայրին՝ Գողգոթային վրայ։ Ի յիշատակ պատմական այս մեծ դէպքին հաստատուեցաւ *Խաչվերաց* մեծ տօնը։

#### FEAST OF THE HOLY CROSS

The Exaltation of the Holy Cross is a major feast celebrated in honor of the Holy Cross. Other traditional churches commemorate this feast on September 14th, while the Armenian Orthodox Church celebrates it on the Sunday closest to the 14<sup>th</sup>. Recorded in ecclesiastical chronicles and in accordance with Holy Tradition, the Holy Cross was ceremoniously elevated only on three occasions before the faithful for veneration. The third and most auspicious occasion on which the Holy Cross was elevated and venerated was upon its return from captivity. In 610, King Khosrov of Persia waged war against Emperor Heracle of Byzantium, conquered Jerusalem, and took the Holy Cross into captivity to Persia in 614 A.D. Heracle regrouped and went against the Persians again. At that time, the general of the Armenian troops was Mjejh Knouni who also managed to gather troops from Persian Armenia. Khosrov suffered a great defeat and the Holy Cross was returned to the Christians in 629. Its ceremonious journey from Persia to Garin, in historic Armenia and from Garin to Constantinople and finally back to Jerusalem was extremely emotion-evoking; the Cross was elevated constantly along the way to provide spiritual comfort for the faithful. It was regarded by all Christians to be the sacred symbol for pious worship. This was the reason for the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross. In our church, the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross takes place with great solemnity and includes the ritual of the Procession and Blessing of the Four Corners of the Earth, or Antasdan. It is most likely that this particular ritual reflects the deep feeling and emotion aroused in Armenia when the Holy Cross was elevated and brought through it on its return to Jerusalem from Persian captivity.

#### GUIDE TO PARTICIPATING IN THE DIVINE LITURGY

WHEN TO MAKE THE SIGN OF THE CROSS. The sign of the cross is made when entering the Church and on these occasions during the Divine Liturgy: (1) after each instance of bowing; (2) when doxology (*Park Hor...*), that is to say, "Glory to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit" is being said or sung; (3) when the Sacred name of our Lord is being solemnly invoked (*Hisoos Krisdos*); (4) at the beginning of the reading of the Gospel; (5) when peace or blessing is being offered by the priest with the words "Peace unto all" (*Khaghaghootune Amenetsoon*); (6) when the priest or deacon swing the censor toward your direction; (7) when the sacred and the central words of the Divine Liturgy are being spoken ("Take, eat, this is My Body..." and "Drink ye all, this is My Blood."); (8) when receiving Holy Communion; and (9) when kissing the Gospel and leaving the Church.

#### Response when Kissing the Cross (during the procession):

#### The faithful say:

3h2tughp ti qhu wnwgh wawmh qwnhaa Uumnion; Hee-shes-cheer yev zeez a-rra-chee an-mah Karinn As-doo-dzo. (Remember me before the immortal Lamb of God.)

#### The priest says:

3h2timi [h2hp wnw2h wGifuh qwnhGG U.umnion]:
Hee-shyal lee-cheer a-rra-chee an-mah ka-rinn As-doo-dzo.
(You shall be remembered before the immortal Lamb of God.)

#### Response for the Kiss of Peace:

#### The giver says:

Քրիստոս ի մէջ մեր յայտնեցաւ: Krees-dos ee mech mer hayd-ne-tsav. (Christ is revealed in our midst.)

#### The receiver says:

*Oրհնեալ է յայտնութիւնն Քրիստոսի:*Orh-nyal eh hayd-noo-tyoo-nun Krees-do-see.
(Blessed is the revelation of Christ.)

#### Response when Kissing the Gospel (after the Divine Liturgy):

#### The faithful say:

3h2tugt Stp qwwtawya wwwmwpwqu pn: Hee-shes-tseh Der za-me-nayn ba-da-ra-kus ko. (May the Lord remember all your sacrifices.)

#### The priest says:

Swgt քեզ Տէր ըստ սրտի քում։ Da-tseh kez Der usd-sur-dee koom. (May the Lord grant to you according to your heart.)

**Participating in the Divine Liturgy:** Please follow the prayers and hymns of the Divine Liturgy in the books provided in the pews. The first half contains the Armenian (*Krapar*) text and modern Armenian translation, while the second half provides the English transliteration and translation. Page numbers are illuminated at the upper left and right sides of the main altar. Please sing along with the hymns the choir is singing.

**Confession and Holy Communion:** Those who are prepared to receive Holy Communion may kneel in the center aisle or remain standing at their pew for the group recitation of the confession (p. 48-49). After the absolution please proceed via the central aisle towards the altar in an orderly manner. Two Parish Council members will be present to assist. Please return to your pew via the side aisles.



# A Perpetual Memorial

for remembrance of our loved ones

The St. James Perpetual Memorial is located in the foyer of the Church on both sides of the entrance to the sanctuary. The archway and modules of the Memorial Plaques were installed in 1991. The archway depicts symbols of the Armenian Church, with the name of our church, St. James Armenian Apostolic Church, at the top of the door. Three sets of wooden modules that hold the Memorial Plaques are on either side of the door. They are made of red oak and enhance and complement the interior of the church sanctuary.

Each Memorial Plaque is 2" x 10"in size. Each plaque bears the name of the departed loved one being memorialized in both Armenian and English, and also bears an inscription of years of birth and passing. Plaques are installed on the Perpetual Memorial at the requested area. Only one person may be remembered on each plaque.

The contribution for each Memorial Plaque is \$1,000. The majority of this donation is placed in the St. James Permanent Fund, where it will generate continuing income for our parish.

Families or individuals wanting to reserve Memorial Plaques in advance may do so, and may also select the area of the Perpetual Memorial on which their plaque(s) will be placed, by making full payment in advance.
