FEAST DAYS

• Monday, September 8, 2014 is the feast of the Nativity (Birth) of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Theotokos (The Holy Mother of God) from Anne.

Nativity of Our Most Holy Mother-of-God and Ever Virgin Mary

The record of the birth of Mary is not found in the Bible. The traditional account of the event is taken from the apocryphal writings, which are not part of the New Testament Scriptures. The traditional teaching which is celebrated in the hymns and verses of the festal liturgy is that Joachim and Anna were a pious Jewish couple. The couple was old and childless. They prayed earnestly to the Lord for a child, since among the Jews barrenness was a sign of God's disfavor. In answer to their prayers, and as the reward of their unwavering fidelity to God, the elderly couple was blessed with the child who was destined, because of her own personal goodness and holiness, to become the Mother of the Messiah-Christ. The Feast of the Nativity of the Theotokos is a celebration as well of the very first preparation of the salvation of the world. Within the context of the Old and the New Testaments, on this radiant day was born the Most Blessed Virgin Mary -- having been chosen through the ages by Divine Providence to bring about the Mystery of the Incarnation of the Word of God. Saints Joachim and Anna made a vow to dedicate the child which the Lord might bestow on them, into the service of God in the Temple. Most Holy Virgin Mary of Herself in purity and virtue surpassed not only all mankind but also the saints and the angels. The Orthodox Church does not accept the doctrine of Catholicism known as the "immaculate conception" -- which teaches that the Mother of God was born without the stain of the original sin of Adam and Eve. This only occurred with the birth of Jesus Christ. However, she was made pure on the day of the Annunciation.

GUIDE TO PARTICIPATING IN THE DIVINE LITURGY

WHEN TO MAKE THE SIGN OF THE CROSS. The sign of the cross is made when entering the Church and on these occasions during the Divine Liturgy: (1) after each instance of bowing; (2) when doxology (*Park Hor...*), that is to say, "Glory to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit" is being said or sung; (3) when the Sacred name of our Lord is being solemnly invoked (*Hisoos Krisdos*); (4) at the beginning of the reading of the Gospel; (5) when peace or blessing is being offered by the priest with the words "Peace unto all" (*Khaghaghootune Amenetsoon*); (6) when the priest or deacon swing the censor toward your direction; (7) when the sacred and the central words of the Divine Liturgy are being spoken ("Take, eat, this is My Body..." and "Drink ye all, this is My Blood."); (8) when receiving Holy Communion; and (9) when kissing the Gospel and leaving the Church.

Response when Kissing the Cross (during the procession):

The faithful say:

3hztushp ti qhu wnwsh wadwf qwnhaa Uumnons: Hee-shes-cheer yev zeez a-rra-chee an-mah Karinn As-doo-dzo. (Remember me before the immortal Lamb of God.)

The priest says:

3h2timi [h2hp wnw2h wGfwf qwnhGG U.umnion]:
Hee-shyal lee-cheer a-rra-chee an-mah ka-rinn As-doo-dzo.
(You shall be remembered before the immortal Lamb of God.)

Response for the Kiss of Peace:

The giver says:

Քրիստոս ի մէջ մեր յայտնեցաւ։ Krees-dos ee mech mer hayd-ne-tsav. (Christ is revealed in our midst.)

The receiver says:

Oրհնեալ է յայտնութիւնն Քրիստոսի: Orh-nyal eh hayd-noo-tyoo-nun Krees-do-see. (Blessed is the revelation of Christ.)

Response when Kissing the Gospel (after the Divine Liturgy):

The faithful sav:

*3իշեսցէ Տէր զամենայն պատարագս բո***։** Hee-shes-tseh Der za-me-nayn ba-da-ra-kus ko. (May the Lord remember all your sacrifices.)

The priest says:

Swgt քեզ Տէր ըստ սրտի քում։
Da-tseh kez Der usd-sur-dee koom.
(May the Lord grant to you according to your heart.)

Participating in the Divine Liturgy: Please follow the prayers and hymns of the Divine Liturgy in the books provided in the pews. The first half contains the Armenian (*Krapar*) text and modern Armenian translation, while the second half provides the English transliteration and translation. Page numbers are illuminated at the upper left and right sides of the main altar. Please sing along with the hymns the choir is singing.

Confession and Holy Communion: Those who are prepared to receive Holy Communion may kneel in the center aisle or remain standing at their pew for the group recitation of the confession (p. 48-49). After the absolution please proceed via the central aisle towards the altar in an orderly manner. Two Parish Council members will be present to assist. Please return to your pew via the side aisles.





A Perpetual Memorial

for remembrance of our loved ones

The St. James Perpetual Memorial is located in the foyer of the Church on both sides of the entrance to the sanctuary. The archway and modules of the Memorial Plaques were installed in 1991. The archway depicts symbols of the Armenian Church, with the name of our church, St. James Armenian Apostolic Church, at the top of the door. Three sets of wooden modules that hold the Memorial Plaques are on either side of the door. They are made of red oak and enhance and complement the interior of the church sanctuary.

Each Memorial Plaque is 2" x 10"in size. Each plaque bears the name of the departed loved one being memorialized in both Armenian and English, and also bears an inscription of years of birth and passing. Plaques are installed on the Perpetual Memorial at the requested area. Only one person may be remembered on each plaque.

The contribution for each Memorial Plaque is \$1,000. The majority of this donation is placed in the St. James Permanent Fund, where it will generate continuing income for our parish.

Families or individuals wanting to reserve Memorial Plaques in advance may do so, and may also select the area of the Perpetual Memorial on which their plaque(s) will be placed, by making full payment in advance.
